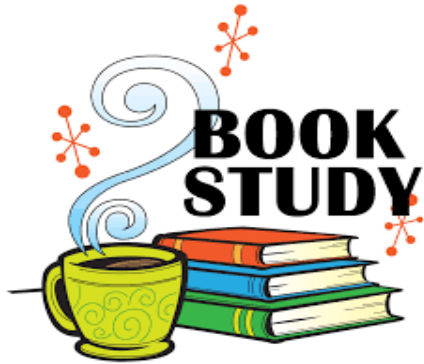


Book Study and Fellowship
